For example, tropical regions support more life than polar regions.

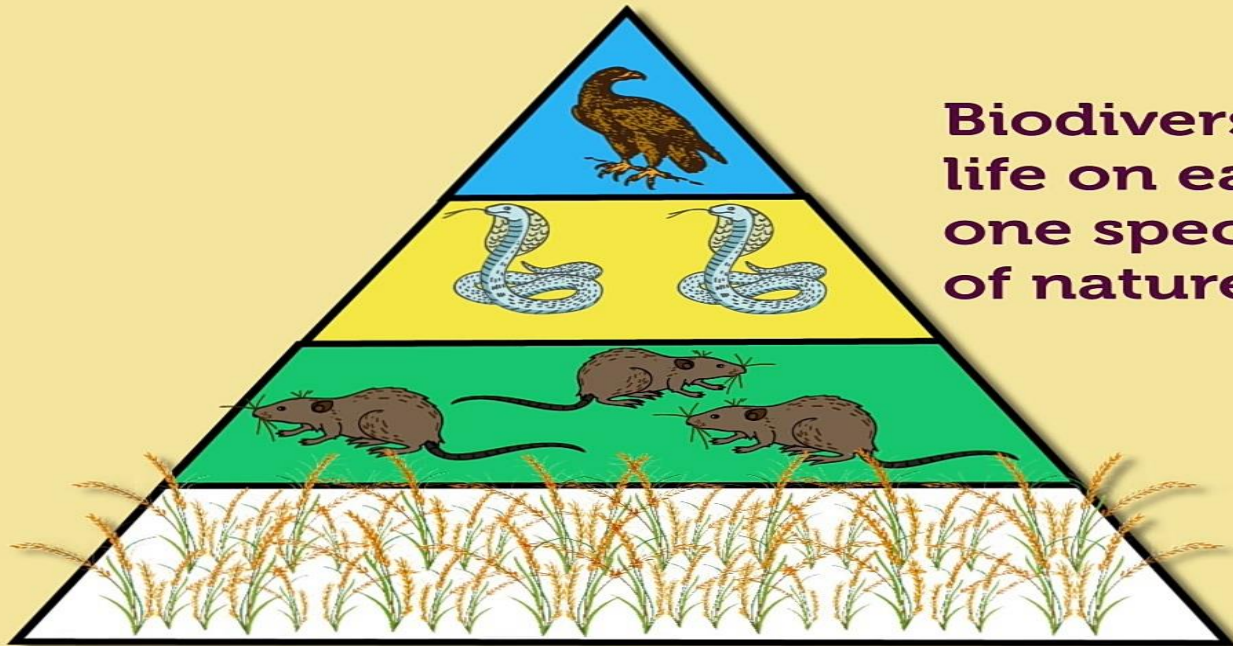
Tropical Regions
